Common Universities Entrance Test (CUET)-2023: UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

Admissions to the 5-Year Integrated PG programs for Academic Year 2023 in the University of Hyderabad will be done through the Common University Entrance Test CUET (UG) -2023. Candidates desiring to apply to the 5-Year Integrated PG programs of the University have to appear for the **Domain** and **Language papers** as mentioned at column 'D' below. The CUET domain and language papers are categorized as **CORE** and **QUALIFYING** for clarity.

A. Core Papers: The merit list for the Integrated PG programs will be determined based on the scores of the candidates in

the paper/s identified as core paper/s. Rank list for admission will be prepared in the order of merit of

score in the core paper/s.

B. Qualifying Papers: Candidates are required to score a minimum cut-off of 50 marks in the qualifying papers (35 marks

for IMA Hindi, IMA Urdu and IMA Telugu) to be considered for admission to the I n t e g r a t e d

PG programs. Only those candidates who score minimum cut-off marks in the qualifying papers will be considered for admission, irrespective of their scores in the core paper/s. The marks scored in

the qualifying papers will not affect the rank.

Note: University of Hyderabad reserves the right to increase or decrease the minimum cut-off to decide on the number of candidates to be called for admission counselling.

Remarks:

- 1. Medium of instruction in UoH is English. Students admitted to language courses too are required to do certain university level mandatory courses and electives that are taught in English medium. Hence, English is compulsory for all programs.
- 2. Candidates can make choice of subjects based on their merit in the entrance examination fulfilling the above criteria.
- 3. For Candidates belonging to SC/ST and differently abled categories, the minimum eligibility is 'Pass' in the qualifying examination.
- 4. Students admitted to IMSc. Biology will branch out to I.M.Sc (Plant Biology and Biotechnology), I.M.Sc (Animal Biology and Biotechnology), I.M.Sc (Biotechnology and Bioinformatics), I.M.Sc (Biochemistry), I.M.Sc (Microbiology and Immunology) and I.M.Sc (Systems and Computational Biology) after three years. CUET (UG) will provide a single window opportunity to students seeking admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) or other participating organizations (including State Universities, Deemed and Private Universities) across the Country.

- 2. Examination will be conducted on multiple days in three shifts, depending on the number of Candidates and Subject choices.

Important Instructions:

- i. Candidates can apply for CUET (UG) 2023 through the "Online" mode only on the website https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/ The Application Form in any other mode will not be accepted.
- ii. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. In no circumstances, candidates will be allowed to fill more than one Application Form. Strict action will be taken, even at a later stage, against such candidates who have filled more than one Application Form.
- iii. Candidates must strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Bulletin and on the website https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/ . Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
- iv. Candidates must ensure that the **e-mail address and Mobile Number** provided in the Online Application Form are their own or Parents/Guardians only as all information/ communication will be sent by NTA through e-mail on the registered e-mail address or SMS on the registered Mobile Number only.
