Sub: Change in the schedule of return of students to campus.- regarding Ref: Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) /GoI Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 30th May 2020 Vice Chancellor's approval dated 1-6-2020.

Reference is invited to the revised Academic Calendar issued by the University on May 20, 2020.

Attention is now drawn to the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) /Gol Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 30th May 2020, on the "Guidelines for Phased Re-opening (Unlock 1)", Clause: Phase II of 1.: "Schools, colleges, educational/training/coaching institutions etc., will be opened after consultations with States and UTs. State Governments/UT administrations may hold consultations at the institution level with parents and other stakeholders. Based on the feedback, a decision on the re-opening of these institutions will be taken in the month of July, 2020".

Based on the aforesaid MHA (GoI) guidelines, a <u>NEW</u> Academic Calendar will be worked out, with special reference to the return of ongoing and outgoing masters and M.Phil/Ph D. students. All the students are therefore advised to defer their travel plans (if any, made so far) to arrive in the University. Please note that under no circumstances a student will be permitted into the campus, until they are duly informed and issued with an e-pass to return to campus. It is the collective responsibility of all stakeholders to ensure safety in the pandemic time. Cooperation from all the students is very much required and will be highly appreciated.
