CIRCULAR

Attention: Pre-2017 Batch PhD Scholars

Sub: Regarding Strict Compliance of the De-Registration Regulations.

Ref: 1. Chapter IX of the Academic Ordinances of the University

2. Vice Chancellors Orders Dated 29-12-2017

The office of the Controller of Examinations has been receiving representations from Ph.D. Scholars those who did not de-register/re-register in time and those who failed to submit thesis within six months after re-registration requesting permission to submit Ph.D. thesis, beyond the maximum prescribed duration.

1. As per the Chapter IX of Academic Ordinances of the University, a Scholar (Ph.D. pre-2017 batch) shall be registered for the duration of 5 years further extendable for a maximum of one more year. If the scholar is unable to complete the research in the prescribed duration as per the above, the scholars are required to go for de-registration. On granting de-registration, a scholar has to re-register within 5 years from the date of de-registration and submit the thesis within 6 months from the date of re-registration.
2. In this regard, the "74th Academic Council meeting held on 15th and 21st April, 2015 resolved that the de-registration and re-registration regulations for Ph.D. duration should be strictly followed". Further to this, the Deans' and Heads' Committee meeting held on 13-12-2016 resolved to strictly follow the AC resolution on de-registration and re-registration.
3. In light of the above, it is instructed that all Scholars do the de-registration and re-registration within the prescribed duration. **It is also informed that w.e.f. 1st February 2018, applications for retrospective de-registration/re-registration will not be accepted under any circumstance and thesis submission beyond the prescribed duration will not be permitted.**
4. The above does not apply for the PhD Scholars admitted from Academic Year 2017 onwards and as per UGC Regulations 2016 the maximum duration for completion of PhD is 5 Years.
