Provisions under Clause 9 of the Academic Ordinances of Chapter IX

- 9.
- a) The name of a Ph.D. student shall be removed from the rolls of the University if she/he fails to submit her/his thesis within a maximum period of 6 years (5 + 1) of her/his admission to the course of research leading to the award of a Ph.D. degree.
- b) The School board on the recommendations of the School/Department/Centre may however consider the request of a candidate whose name has been removed from the rolls of the University under sub-clause (a) above for de-registration and to get re-registered and become eligible for submission of her/his thesis provided she/he submits the thesis not later than six months from the date of reregistration.
- c) The gap between the removal of the name/de-registration and re-registration should not be more than five years. No fee will be charged for the period of de-registration or from the date of removal of the name till the date of re-registration.
- d) A Ph.D. student may also submit an application for de-registration and withdrawal from the programme due to personal reasons through proper channel (her/his supervisor, the doctoral committee, Head/Dean) but only after the completion of the residential requirement for submission of the thesis. Such candidates can re-register as per Clause (b) above.
