Sub: Non-compliance of minimum credits requirement per semester as prescribed by NEP

Ref: Decision of 90th AC in its meeting held on 15th July 2022 regarding implementation of NEP-2020.



All the UG / PG / Int. PG students are hereby informed that as per NEP 2020 and NCF guidelines, a minimum of 20 credits has to be successfully completed in every semester, and a minimum of 40 credits per academic year.

Further, during the notification of end-semester examination results, the office of the Controller of Examinations observed that several students have not completed this mandatory requirement of NEP-2020.

Hence, all these afore-mentioned students admitted from academic year 2024 onwards (NEP batches) who could not complete 20 credits in the previous semester have to opt for additional course/s in the present semester and fulfill the minimum credit requirement/s. It may be noted that if minimum required 40 credits/academic year is not fulfilled, such students shall not be eligible for award of degree/diploma.

Students may take note of this and comply accordingly.
