The National Coordination Committee (NCC) of the PMRF scheme made the selection of the above students. Each fellow under the PMRF scheme will receive a starting monthly fellowship of Rs. 70,000/-, which may increase to a maximum monthly fellowship of Rs. 80,000/- towards the end of Ph.D., provided the performance during the initial years of Ph.D. is satisfactory. PMRF Fellowship will be paid from the start date of the current semester of the academic calendar 2022-23. Selected Fellows will be subject to a rigorous annual review, and PMRF will be continued only if the experts in the review are convinced about their performance. The first review of the selected Lateral Entry Fellows will be conducted in May 2023. The PMRF fellows must satisfy the teaching requirements as outlined in the PMRF guidelines.

Apart from this, each fellow would be eligible for Rs. 2 Lakhs research grant per year. UoH was allotted 19 PMRF fellowships (15 lateral entry channel and 4 direct entry channel fellowships) for May 2022. Against 15 lateral entry channel fellowships, 13 were selected by the NCC of the PMRF scheme. UoH thanks the Ministry of Education and the NCC of the PMRF scheme for the same.

There will be another announcement in Dec/Jan 2022 (PMRF Cycle 10) for the PMRF aspirants at UoH.
