Each fellow under the PMRF scheme will receive a starting monthly fellowship of Rs. 70,000/-, which may increase to a maximum monthly fellowship of Rs. 80,000/- towards the end of Ph.D., provided the performance during the initial years of Ph.D. is satisfactory. Apart from this, each fellow would be eligible for an Rs. 2 Lakhs research grant per year. UoH was allotted 10 PMRF fellowships (8 lateral entry channel and 2 direct entry channel fellowships) for Dec 2021. Against the 8 lateral entry channel fellowships, 8 were selected by the NCC of the PMRF scheme. UoH thanks the Ministry of Education and the NCC of the PMRF scheme for the same.
