Common Universities Entrance Test (CUET)-2025: UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

Admissions to the UG programs for Academic Year 2025 in the **Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University, Mulugu, Telangana State** will be done through the Common University Entrance Test CUET (UG) -2025. Candidates desirous admission may apply to the UG programs of the University. The candidates have to appear for the **Domain** and **Language papers** as mentioned in the column '**D**' in the table given below. The CUET domain and language papers are categorized as **CORE** and **QUALIFYING** for clarity.

- A. Core Papers:** The merit list for the UG programs will be determined based on the scores of the candidates in the paper/s identified as Core Paper/s. Merit list for admission counselling will be prepared based on the marks scored in the Core Paper/s.
- B. Qualifying Papers:** Candidates are required to score a **minimum of 50% marks in the qualifying papers.** The candidates who score minimum cut-off marks in the qualifying papers will only be considered for calling for admission counselling, irrespective of their scores in the core paper/s. The marks scored in the qualifying papers will not affect the rank.

Note: The Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University (SSCTU) reserves the right to increase or decrease the minimum cut-off to decide on the number of candidates to be called for admission counselling.
