**REVISED ACADEMIC REGULATIONS FOR THE (JULY-DECEMBER 2021) based on UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar in view the Covid 19 Pandemic July 2021, dated: 16.07.2021**

1. Appearing in the end semester exam is mandatory for all students. Students must register for the end semester exams to be held in December 2021/January 2022 and download their Hall Tickets from e-governance to appear for the exams.
2. The attendance requirement of 75% stands waived for this semester in view of the ongoing Pandemic.
3. The final result in each course shall be determined based on the continuous assessment and performance in the end semester exams to be held in December 2021/January 2022 which shall be in the ratio of 50:50 in case of theory courses.
4. For the practical/laboratory courses, the final marks shall be determined based on the continuous assessment of the laboratory records and will be scaled to 100 marks.
5. In case of dissertations/project reports, the student shall be assessed based on the dissertation/report submitted. Internal committee(s) of the Academic units shall assess the dissertation/project and award the marks/grades for the PG Courses. All M.Tech project reports shall be evaluated by External Examiner.
6. Final semester students having backlogs of previous semesters including foundation courses if any, and doing recourse in current semester will have to appear for the exams and pass all papers to be eligible for the Degree.
7. The Academic units have been authorized to conduct the end semester exams in online/offline/blended mode as mentioned in UGC letter dated 16-7-2021.
8. The Examination Timings may be decided by the concerned faculty in consultation with the students to avoid any clash of time-table.
9. The supplementary/special supplementary/Improvement exams will be conducted separately. A separate notification will be issued for the same.
10. PhD Coursework evaluation shall be made based on the continuous assessment for 50 marks and end semester exam for 50 marks.

All Academic Units are requested to check the mapping of courses, credits etc. of all the courses in e-governance portal and ensure its correctness before entry of marks for the July-December 2021. Earlier communication with regard to Revised Academic Ordinances for July-Dec 2021 semester may please be ignored.
