Step :-1



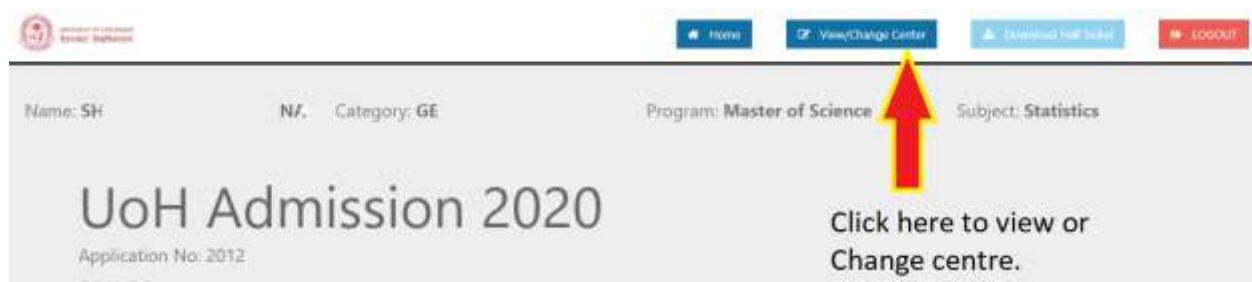

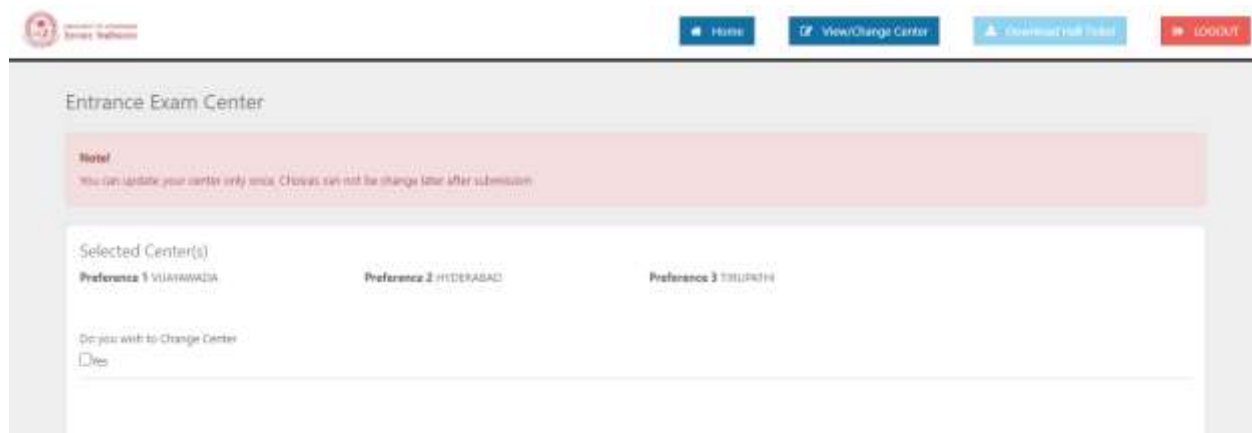


