**Instructions to the Candidates to Appear for the Online Interview
for the Admission in Ph.D. Programme in the Centre for Regional Studies**

Dear Candidate,

1. It is a pleasure to inform you that you are shortlisted to appear for the online interview for the admission in **Ph.D. programme** in the Centre for Regional Studies (CRS), School of Social Sciences, University of Hyderabad.
2. The online interview will start **at 02:30 pm on 12 February 2021, Friday**. A separate time-slot of your turn to appear for the online interview will be sent to you.
3. Upload your **eligibility certificates** on or before 10 February 2021 by 5:00 pm by using <https://admissions2020.uohyd.ac.in:824/> Only pdf/jpg files will be allowed for upload.
4. The Admission Committee has every right to cancel the interview of a particular candidate who fails to upload the eligibility certificates on the above link.
5. The candidate is strongly advised to send his/her **Research Proposal** in word format to headcrs@uohyd.ac.in email on or before 10 February 2021 by 5:00 pm.
6. While writing the research proposal, it is advised to refer the core research areas mentioned in the prospectus which is accessible on the University website. These research proposals shall be strictly in these areas only. You will not be interviewed without submission of the research proposal.
7. The online interview will be held on **Google Meet** only. You will be provided two Google Meeting links;
 - a) Use the first Google Meeting Link as 'Waiting Room' where you report by 02:25 pm on 12 February 2021, Friday, and wait until your turn comes for the interview. This link will be shared with you one day in advance of the online interview schedule, i.e., 11 February 2021.
 - b) Use the second Google Meeting Link to attend the online interview. This link will be shared with you only when your turn comes to appear for the online interview on the day of the interview, i.e., 12 February 2021.
 - c) The candidate is strongly advised to have a Gmail Account in order to login the above two Google Meeting Links.
 - d) The candidate is advised to appear for the online interview from a safe place where there will not be any disturbance/ noise etc. in order to have a clear question and answer session during the online interview.
 - e) The candidate is instructed to use reasonably a good device such as desktop computer/ laptop or mobile in which video and audio function perfectly with a stable internet connection. This is important since you, as a candidate, will have to keep the 'video on' until the interview is completed.
